3 Days

DAY 1: Johannesburg to Panorama Route and God's Window

We collect clients at OR Tambo International airport or lodges in the area between 6:00 - 7:30 am. We will advise you your exact pick up time previous day. On the way to Hazyview, we will follow the breathtaking Panorama route, heading past old fashioned towns like Dullstroom & Lydenburg. We will visit the world's



3rd largest canyon - the Blyde River Canyon, then Bourke's luck potholes, as well as Lisbon Falls and the scenic God's Window. We will plan a stop for lunch en-route.

The last stop is a little town called Graskop, famous for the array of curio shops. After strolling through Graskop, we will then go to our accommodation in Hazyview. Feel free to relax before enjoying dinner. We do advise an early night, as we'll leave early the next day.

DAY 2: Kruger National Park

Your guide will be picking you up early, ready for our most exciting day. With packed breakfasts in hand we begin a full day Kruger Safari on open 4x4's. Your guide will explore the best areas of the southern KNP where we find game viewing to be the best. Have your cameras ready as your guide will make sure you have an unforgettable safari.

Along the way you will stop for breakfast & lunch at different rest camps and return to the lodge around 3:30 - 4:00 pm to relax and unwind before dinner.

We game drive until about 10 - 11am after which we will return to the lodge to pick up our bags and transfer back to Johannesburg

JOINING INFORMATION:

We pick up from OR Tambo or Surrounding lodges/ Hotels (5kms Radius). Departure is usually early; a consultant will communicate your exact departure time the evening before.

Airport (bus terminal) or surrounding hotels.

ABOUT THE KRUGER:

Kruger National Park, in the Mpumalanga Province of South Africa, is among the world's greatest nature reserves. It is one of the few places on earth where wildlife can be seen in such great variety and at such close quarters. Some 520 bird, 114 reptile and 146 mammal species, including the fabled Big Five - elephant, rhino, lion, leopard and buffalo, densely populate the park. Although in nature there are no guarantees, in Kruger Park you stand the best chance of thrilling sightings of game. From some of Africa's largest prides of lion, to birds found nowhere else within the country's borders.

The present Kruger Park is immense, covering 19,685 km², an area almost the size of Wales or two thirds of Belgium. There are more than 3000 km of roads on which to explore the Park. Obviously in a limited time, one can do only so much, however our experience shows us which are the best roads to take at certain times of the year, ensuring you get the most of your visit to the Park. Our tour focuses mainly on the Central and Southern areas of the park, as it has the largest concentration of game.

CLIMATE:

In winter (April to September) the days are mild (average about 23° C), with sometimes cool nights (down to 6°



C). In the summer the days average 30° C, but sometimes exceed 40° C, with the welcome cooling effect of afternoon thunderstorms. Rain in the summer months (October - March i.e. “rainy season”) varies from about 800mm in the south, to 500mm in the northern areas.
