DAY 1
Transfer & Afternoon Safari

Guests will be collected from various lodges and hotels within a 5 km radius of the OR Tambo International Airport between 6:30 am and 6:45 am, and then from the OR Tambo International Airport shuttle and bus Terminal between 6:45 and 7:00 am, we depart at 7:15 am.

Your consultant can help discuss and arrange suitable pre tour accommodation if need be. Clients can fly directly into Skukuza Kruger National Park, or Kruger Mpumalanga International Airports and be collected by one of our guides at no additional cost if you prefer. Please note these are shared departures.



We will travel directly to our lodge in Hazyview and arrive between 11:30 am – 12:00 pm. Guests will have time to relax, unpack and enjoy a light lunch, there after enjoy a swim or walk around the beautiful Lodge and it's walking trail.

We depart at around 15.45 Pm for a Sunset / Night safari in the Kruger National Park before returning to the lodge at approximately 20.00 pm for a lovely dinner, and a good night's rest. Do note the sunset times vary between Winter and Summer. Guests traveling in winter months will have a longer night safari while summer travelers will enjoy beautiful sunsets.

DAY 2 Kruger National Park

Your guide will be picking you up early, ready for an exciting day. With packed breakfasts in hand we begin a full day Kruger Safari on open 4x4's. Your guide will explore the best areas of the southern KNP where we find game viewing to be the best. Have your cameras ready as your guide will make sure you have an unforgettable safari. Starting early is the best time to see predators.

Your guide will stop after about 3 hours for a breakfast and bathroom break and chance to get a coffee. We then continue with your safari, Kruger offers a variety of eco zones and each one has a different range of wildlife, we visit rivers and watering holes as well as plains and Bushveld regions.

We then stop for lunch at a rest camp, where this meal will be for your own account, time to do some curio shopping or enjoy a cold beer! The guide will then continue with the safari heading towards the lodge, we arrive around 15.30 – 16.00 pm, time to relax, swim and have a great dinner.

DAY 3 God's Window and the Panorama Route

Visit Gods Window, Bourkes Luck Potholes, Blyde River Canyon (world's 3rd largest canyon), Lisbon waterfall, the 3 rondavels and the town of Graskop.

Today we start with delicious hot breakfast at the lodge at 7.30 Am and your guide will meet you at 8 am in a closed air-conditioned vehicle. The Panorama route starts after a 45 min drive from Hazyview, however we climb almost 1 000m in elevation to the Northern Drakensburg Mountain range. The temperatures vary a lot from Hazyview, so bring a jacket and comfortable walking shoes as we do some lovely walks.

We visit God's Window which allows people a window from the escarpment and a 1 000 m drop below one can see as far as Kruger and beyond on a clear day. Your comfortable walking shoes will be needed as the various lookout points have paths and trails to the view sights. To get to the top takes an average person around 15-20 minutes, but it is worth the walk through a natural rainforest environment.

Bourkes Luck Potholes is a stunning natural formation created by water erosion over hundreds of years. The Bourke's Luck potholes have round carvings and holes with different sizes formed in the Treur River and Blyde river confluence in the red sandstone. Your guides will brief you on all the history of the region. Guests can use small foot bridges and walk over the chasms, looking at the water flowing through the cracks and holes. There are also several small but beautiful waterfalls that litter the area, we spend about 1 hour here and it's a great walk of about 1 Km in total.



Blyde River Canyon, the 3rd largest canyon in the world. The canyon is over 40km long and is as deep as 1 200m. The canyon contains vast amounts of plant life with rivers and dams making up the floor of the canyon. At a certain lookout point on the canyon, guests get to see another beauty of the Panorama Tour, the 3 Rondavels - The Rondavels get their name from their similar appearance to the Rondavel houses a traditional hut commonly built in Africa, these 3 outcrops stand prominently from the landscape.

The Guides will also visit Lisbon falls, a beautiful waterfall that has a strong flow of water throughout the year. Lunch and some curio shopping will be in the Highveld town of Graskop, famous for its great Pancakes and our lunch venue for the day, there some great small shops and guests will have time to enjoy a stroll through the town.

Arrive back at the Lodge at about 4 Pm after a great day, enjoy a drink, a swim and dinner at the lodge, before an early start for a last morning safari in Kruger.

DAY 4

Kruger National Park Safari

We always depart before sunrise, and this is the best time for viewing wildlife as predators are mostly active in the early hours of the day. Your guide will focus on animals and regions not yet seen or covered, The Kruger National Park has 148 mammal species and over 500 bird species so there is always something to see, no safari is ever the same.

Kruger has a huge network of roads to choose from guides will safari in different areas of the park in different seasons, giving clients the chance to see more sightings and the beautiful wilderness and vegetation.

We return to the lodge around 11 am, today we have an afternoon at leisure, swim, enjoy some great walks around the lodges, try our local beers or just enjoy our great African weather. A light lunch and tasty dinner will be served at the lodge.

DAY 5

Morning Safari in an open vehicle & Return Transfer to Johannesburg

We begin our final day with an early morning game drive, your guide will pick you up again with packed breakfasts on an open 4 x 4. Our last chance to see the animals that may have eluded us the day before. Every day in nature is different, who knows what sighting awaits us. We game drive until about 10 –11am after which we will return to the lodge for a quick freshen up, a chance to say goodbye to your guide and get ready for the shuttle back to Johannesburg.

Clients are collected by the shuttle at around 11.30 am, and we return to Johannesburg OR Tambo shuttle terminal and or lodges within a 5 km Radius, arriving between 17.00 – 18.00 pm

ACCOMMODATION:

Umbhaba Lodge or Similar. If not available your consultant will advise you other options (Quality en-suite air-conditioned units). Umbhaba Eco Lodge is situated just 1 km outside Hazyview on the R40, between Hazyview and White River. We are surrounded by natural, indigenous bush including the Umbhaba Tree (Lowveld Chestnut) after which the lodge is named. The lodge is built among stunning dams and water features, overlooking the Sabie valley in the distance. We have abundant bird life and the most beautiful sunsets, making it the perfect location for a sundowner after an amazing safari in the Kruger National Park.

27 Standard Rooms and 16 Superior room the lodge is designed mainly for clients visiting the Kruger national park and surrounding Panorama Route and not primarily as a holiday resort. There are no self-catering rooms available, the lodge offers a great indoor and outside restaurant with a selection of great meals and a licenced bar.

There 5 dams on the property and plenty trails and gardens to walk around enjoying the beauty of the Mpumalanga Lowveld. With safe secure and modern air-conditioned rooms, WIFI thought the property, we are looking forward to tour visit.

Each room has its very own private balcony, all en-suite & air-conditioned with Wi-Fi.

ABOUT THE KRUGER:

Kruger National Park, in the Mpumalanga Province of South Africa, is among the world's greatest nature reserves.



It is one of the few places on earth where wildlife can be seen in such great variety and at such close quarters. Some 520 bird, 114 reptile and 146 mammal species, including the fabled Big Five - elephant, rhino, lion, leopard and buffalo, densely populate the park. Although in nature there are no guarantees, in Kruger Park you stand the best chance of thrilling sightings of game. From some of Africa's largest prides of lion, to birds found nowhere else within the country's borders.

The present Kruger Park is immense, covering 19,685 km², an area almost the size of Wales or two thirds of Belgium. There are more than 3000 km of roads on which to explore the Park. Obviously in a limited time, one can do only so much, however our experience shows us which are the best roads to take at certain times of the year, ensuring you get the most of your visit to the park. Our tour focuses mainly on the Central and Southern areas of the park, as it has the largest concentration of game.

CLIMATE:

In winter (April to September) the days are mild (average about 23° C), with sometimes cool nights (down to 6° C). In the summer the days average 30° C, but sometimes exceed 40° C, with the welcome cooling effect of afternoon thunderstorms. Rain in the summer months (October - March i.e. "rainy season") varies from about 800mm in the south, to 500mm in the northern areas.
