

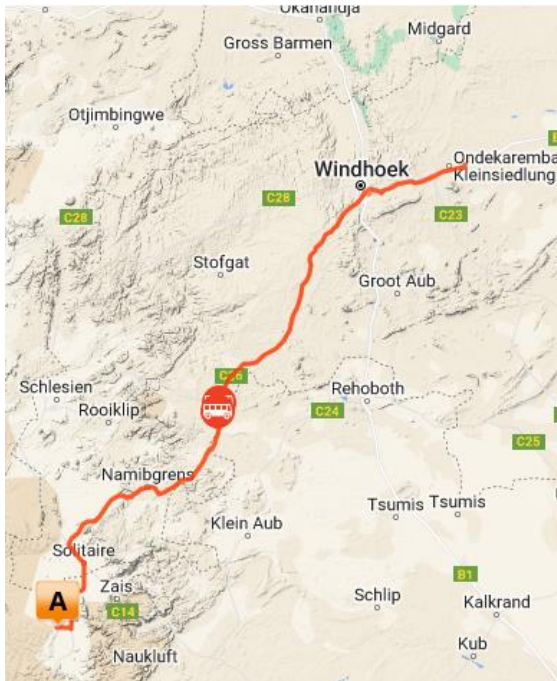

3 Days| Namibia

DAY 1: WINDHOEK - SOSSUVLEI

Guests are collected in Windhoek at approximately 07h00 and transferred to the Namib Desert Lodge in Sossuvlei, based at the foot of ancient, fossilised dunes. Arriving around lunch you will have some time relax and grab a bite to eat before heading out on an afternoon Dune Drive at the Gondwana Namib Park.

After your dune excursion you head back to the lodge to enjoy a delicious buffet dinner.

DAY 2: SOSSUSVLEI

An early start to the day sees you heading out on a morning Guided Sossusvlei Excursion.

Much of the morning is spent climbing the highest sand dunes in the world. Big Daddy offers a strenuous climb, but the view along the crest is completely worth it. Upon descent, the whispering sands of the Namib lead to the ancient camelthorn trees of Dead Vlei – one of the most photographed areas in Sossusvlei. Finally, a trip to Sossusvlei isn't complete without visiting the Sesriem Canyon. After a morning spent exploring Sossusvlei you head back to the lodge for some lunch and time to relax and soak up the beautiful desert scenery.

In the afternoon you have time to relax and soak up the desert sun by the pool or choose one of the optional activities on offer from unguided hiking trails to E-bikes.

DAY 3: SOSSUSVLEI - WINDHOEK
