


8 Day Cape Town to Garden Route & Kruger Comfort Tour

TOUR ITINERARY

8 Days | Garden Route & Kruger National Park

This this tour takes in 2 of South Africa Iconic destinations, the Garden Route in all its beauty and the Kruger National Park for South Africa's best Big 5 Safari. Do note this is a mixture of 2 tours with a flight in-between (own Cost). Spend a few days in Cape Town before this trip and then join us and see the best South Africa has to offer.

Information is subject to change. Travel times and accommodation can change depending on road or weather conditions, etc. These are used as a guideline only.

<u>DAY 1: CAPE TOWN – HERMANUS – CAPE AGULHAS</u>

We depart from Cape Town/Stellenbosch early on Monday morning for Hermanus. We follow the scenic coastal road, stopping at Betties Bay to view a colony of endangered African penguins. You can spend the afternoon in the seaside resort town of Hermanus, famous for hundreds of Southern Right Whales during the Whale season (July to November) and many shops, beaches, restaurants and markets. In the afternoon we will drive on to Cape Agulhas, the most southern tip of Africa, where we visit a viewpoint known as the "real" place where the Indian and Atlantic Oceans meet. (Shark cage diving clients will be picked up very early in the morning by the shark operator and will miss the first half of day 1 which includes the visit to the African Penguin Colony & Hermanus).

Travel Time: ±3 hrs / 250 km

DAY 2: CAPE AGULHAS - OUDTSHOORN

We travel to Oudtshoorn in the Little Karoo, known as the Ostrich Capital of the World, via the scenic and spectacular Route 62, which is South Africa's longest wine route. We will have a lovely lunch and wine tasting at a local winery, before checking into our accommodation, which is on a working game farm in the Little Karoo. As the sun goes down, we can enjoy a tour of the ostrich farm, taking in the views of the Outeniqua and Swartberg mountain ranges in the background.

DAY 3: OUDTSHOORN – WILDERNESS - SEDGEFIELD

After breakfast we head over the marvellous Outeniqua Mountain pass where we will explore Wilderness National Park with some canoes. Enjoy an easy paddle up the Touw River through indigenous forest, enjoying the abundance of birdlife. After about 40 minutes, the canoes will be left for a 2km hike along a boardwalk, which will take us to a lovely waterfall and rock pools. Late afternoon you can spend exploring Sedgefield with its spectacular views and beaches.

DAY 4: SEDGEFIELD - TSITSIKAMMA - ADDO

This morning en-route to Addo our first stop is the beautiful seaside town of Knysna. We will visit the Knysna Heads viewpoint for some magnificent views over the Knysna River estuary and the Indian Ocean. After Knysna we are off to Tsitsikamma National Park. En route we will stop at Bloukrans Bridge to view the world's highest bungee jump bridge (216 meters). There is plenty of time for the adventure seekers among you to test their courage. The late morning will be spent in Tsitsikamma National Park with its unique combination of indigenous forest and beautiful Indian Ocean coastline. The Park has a wide choice of activities for all, including hiking, crossing a suspension bridge and swimming. Early afternoon we will leave the Garden Route for Big 5 country, Addo.

DAY 5: ADDO – GQEBERHA (PORT ELIZABETH) - JOHANNESBURG

We will spend the morning exploring Addo Elephant National Park. We will spend up to 2 - 3 hours exploring the 28,000-hectare National reserve with approximately 600 elephants and some Cape buffalo, lion, black rhino, warthog, zebra, eland, kudu, hartebeest and many more animals.

After an exciting morning of game viewing, we will drop you off in Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth) at approximately 1-2pm. You will be dropped off directly at the airport for a flight to Johannesburg. The airfare is not included in your tour fare; however your consultant can help with this and advise you on the best flight to book. The flight needs to be booked for 2pm or after.

On Arrival in Johannesburg an Airport Transfer will pick you up and take you to your hotel for a good night's rest at Safari Club lodge.

DAY 6: JOHANNESBURG TO GREATER KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

We depart Johannesburg and head for the Greater Kruger National Park where our Safari adventure begins. After travelling through the Highveld farmlands, we descend the dramatic Drakensberg Escarpment and into the Lowveld, home to some of the most pristine Private Game Reserves in South Africa and the world-renowned Kruger National Park. We arrive at Thornhill Safari Lodge in time for a delicious lunch.

After some relaxation time, we venture out on a late afternoon/evening Big five game drive in open 4x4 Safari vehicles in one of the neighboring Private Reserves. Sundowner drinks and snacks are enjoyed at one of the waterholes en route; enjoying the sights, sounds and smells of the African Bushveld before continuing our game drive into the night. After an exciting evening, we return to Thornhill to experience a traditional South African meal around the log fire.

The lodge offers comfortable accommodation in authentic thatched roof chalets. Vibrant fabrics and local hardwood furniture all create that rustic yet stylish bush atmosphere. Sit back and relax in our Bar/Lounge area or sip cocktails around the swimming pool and treetop viewing deck overlooking the majestic Drakensberg Mountain Range and a neverending wilderness.

DAY 7: KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

An early rise as you are greeted by your guide as you enjoy coffee and rusks before embarking on a day of exploration in the acclaimed Kruger National Park.





The Park offers an unrivalled wildlife experience that ranks with the best not only in Africa, but around the world. Its rich history dates back to 1898, and its goal has always been to protect the wildlife of the South African Lowveld. Today, this national treasure offers two million hectares of unspoiled African bushveld and captivating wildlife.

Truly the flagship of the South African National Parks, Kruger remains home to an impressive number of species ranging from 336 trees, 49 fish, 34 amphibians, 114 reptiles, 517 birds and 146 mammals.

Look forward to a safari experience that unfolds from the moment you enter the Kruger Park and explore the best game drive routes the Park has to offer.

Our game drive takes us through a landscape like no other, with an amazing variety of wildlife, birds, plants and trees. We break at a remote picnic site to enjoy a scrumptious bush brunch before continuing our Safari discovering the unspoilt and untamed wilderness that makes the Kruger Park so special. Our journey continues as we stop off at the various viewpoints and waterholes whilst game viewing and bird watching along the way.

We return to the Lodge and enjoy yet another taste of traditional African cuisine before retiring to the peaceful sounds of the African night.

DAY 8: GREATER KRUGER NATIONAL PARK - JOHANNESBURG

We begin our day with coffee and rusks before venturing out on an early morning game walk exploring the reserve on foot. Our qualified field guides will share their passion with you as you learn some fascinating facts about the environment and its inhabitants that surround you.

After a tasty breakfast, we bid you farewell as you continue further on your South African journey. Ascending the scenic Drakensberg Escarpment, we stop off to view the spectacular setting of the Three Rondawels towering over the Blyde River Canyon en route back to Johannesburg.

We return you to your hotel or OR Tambo airport in Johannesburg around 17h00.
