ITINERARY

6 Days South Africa

DAY 1: Transfer & Afternoon Safari

We collect clients at OR Tambo International airport or lodges in the area between 6:00 - 7:30 am. We will





advise you your exact pick up time previous day. Today we make our way to the famous Panorama route on our way to our safari. We will visit the world's 3rd largest canyon - the Blyde River Canyon, then Bourke's luck potholes, the Three Rondavels, as well as Lisbon Falls and the scenic God's Window. We will plan a stop for lunch en-route at a small town called Graskop, where we will have lunch and do some souvenir shopping. We then head for our accommodation where we can relax before dinner.

DAY 2: Kruger National Park

Your guide will be picking you up early, ready for our most exciting day. With packed breakfasts in hand we begin a full day Kruger Safari on open 4x4's. Your guide will explore the best areas of the southern KNP where we find game viewing to be the best. Have your cameras ready as your guide will make sure you have an unforgettable safari.

Along the way you will stop for breakfast & lunch at different rest camps and return to the lodge around 3:30 - 4:00 pm to relax and unwind before dinner.

DAY 3 & 4: Full Day open vehicle safari in the Kruger National Park

Today we enjoy a full day open vehicle safari, departing before sunrise. It is meant to be an unforgettable, yet relaxed day. We return to the lodge at about 15:30 -16:00 PM for some leisure time, a swim, and time to rest after the past few exciting days. We have dinner and get to bed for the next day's animal sightings in the Park. We do advise an early night, as we'll leave early the next day.

DAY 5: Full Day open vehicle safari in the Kruger National Park

Today we depart before sunrise, Hazyview is situated close to 2 entry gates to the Kruger; this gives you the opportunity to see different areas of the Kruger Park and the guide will focus on finding different wildlife that might have alluded you on the previous safaris. We will visit various water holes, lookout points, rivers and have our pre-packed breakfasts at a local picnic venue. After that, we will visit bird hides and look for the mighty Big 5 again. Where we stop for breakfast and lunch depends on the guide's choice, and the direction he chooses to take in the KNP on the day; seasons change and this also changes which areas we spend more time on safari. We return to the lodge (between 3:30 & 4PM) for a swim, relaxing





and catching up on the last few days of pictures and experiences. But be sure to get to bed early, as you will have to get up before sunrise again for your final safari the next day

DAY 6: Morning Safari in an open vehicle & Return Transfer to Johannesburg

We begin our final day with an early morning game drive, you guide will pick you up again with packed breakfasts on an open $4 \ge 4$. Our last chance to see the animals and catch the crisp early morning air of the Kruger National Park. Every day in nature is different, who knows what sighting awaits us. We game drive until about 10 –11am after which we will return to the lodge to pick up our bags and transfer back to Johannesburg

We expect to arrive at Johannesburg Airport (O R Tambo) and surrounding hotels between 4 – 5PM. There you will depart to your various lodges and hotels after a great safari experience.

NB: Clients flying out of OR Tambo on the last day, please do not book flights earlier than 19:00 PM for domestic flights and 20:00 PM for international flights as we cannot guarantee on -time arrival at OR Tambo International Airport.

ABOUT THE KRUGER:

Kruger National Park, in the Mpumalanga Province of South Africa, is among the world's greatest nature reserves. It is one of the few places on earth where wildlife can be seen in such great variety and at such close quarters. Some 520 bird, 114 reptile and 146 mammal species, including the fabled Big Five - elephant, rhino, lion, leopard and buffalo, densely populate the park. Although in nature there are no guarantees, in Kruger Park you stand the best chance of thrilling sightings of game. From some of Africa's largest prides of lion, to birds found nowhere else within the country's borders.

The present Kruger Park is immense, covering 19,685 km2, an area almost the size of Wales or two thirds of Belgium. There are more than 3000 km of roads on which to explore the Park. Obviously in a limited time, one can do only so much, however our experience shows us which are the best roads to take at certain times of the year, ensuring you get the most of your visit to the Park. Our tour focuses mainly on the Central and Southern areas of the park, as it has the largest concentration of game.

CLIMATE:

In winter (April to September) the days are mild (average about 23° C), with sometimes cool nights (down to 6° C). In the summer the days average 30° C, but sometimes exceed 40° C, with the welcome cooling effect of afternoon thunderstorms. Rain in the summer months (October - March i.e. "rainy season") varies from about 800mm in the south, to 500mm in the northern areas.
