ITINERARY

3 Days South Africa

DAY 1:

Arrive at Lodge - Greater Kruger National Park

This safari is aimed at guests who want to drive themselves to the Kruger Park to join an authentic Big 5 African Safari. If you are looking at renting a car there are many available car rentals in Johannesburg, Nelspruit or Hoedspruit, pending your travel arrangements. Your consultant can help advise you.

Today you make your way to Thornhill Safari Lodge located in the heart of the bushveld. Once you check in, you will be served a scrumptious traditional African lunch. Please make sure you arrive before 2 pm so that you have time to settle in and enjoy your lunch before heading off on your Big 5 game drive which will take place in a neighboring private reserve.





All game drives are conducted by experienced rangers and game trackers ensuring your safari will remain an unforgettable experience.

Sundowner drinks and snacks are enjoyed at one of the waterholes in the reserve; take in the sights, sounds and smells of the African Bushveld before continuing your game drive into the night.

After an exciting evening, we return to Thornhill to experience a traditional South African meal around the log fire. After dinner you can sit back and relax in the bar/lounge area or sip cocktails around the swimming pool. Don't forget to visit the stunning treetop viewing deck overlooking the majestic Drakensberg Mountain Range.

DAY 2: Kruger National Park

An early rise as you are greeted by your guide as you enjoy coffee and rusks before embarking on a day of exploration in the acclaimed Kruger National Park. The Park offers an unrivalled wildlife experience that ranks with the best not only in Africa, but around the world. Its rich history dates back to 1898, and its goal has always been to protect the wildlife of the South African Lowveld. Today, this national treasure offers two million hectares of unspoiled African bushveld and captivating wildlife.

Truly the flagship of the South African National Parks, Kruger remains home to an impressive number of species ranging from 336 trees, 49 fish, 34 amphibians, 114 reptiles, 517 birds and 146 mammals. Look forward to a safari experience that unfolds from the moment you enter the Kruger Park and explore the best game drive routes the Park has to offer.

Our game drive takes us through a landscape like no other, with an amazing variety of wildlife, birds, plants and trees. We break at a remote picnic site to enjoy a scrumptious bush brunch before continuing our Safari discovering the un-spoilt and untamed wilderness that makes the Kruger Park so special. Our journey continues as we stop off at the various viewpoints and waterholes whilst game viewing and bird watching along the way.

We return to the Lodge and enjoy yet another taste of traditional African cuisine before retiring to the peaceful sounds of the African night.

DAY 3:

Greater Kruger National Park - Johannesburg

After a tasty breakfast, we bid you farewell as you continue further on your South African journey.

If you are driving back to Johannesburg and have the time, we recommend stopping off at Blyde River Canyon to view the spectacular setting of the Three Rondawels. The other option is to catch a quick flight back to Johannesburg via Hoedspruit Airport (Eastgate Airport) or Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport in Nelspruit. If you need transfers to these airports, please let us know as it can be pre-arranged.

Included Activities: Morning game walk in the Guernsey Private Nature Reserve

Visit to the Three Rondawels and Blyde River Canyon.

Tour Information

ACCOMMODATION:

The Kruger lodge is located in the greater Kruger area. The stunning area comes complete with the typical wooded savannah, offset with Marula, Jackalberry and Leadwood trees, all of which just adds to the atmosphere of the lodge. The lodge offers comfortable accommodation in 13 Authentic thatched roof chalets. Accommodation is comprised of twin, double and family units. Special sleeping arrangements can be organized for our younger guests.

Vibrant fabrics and local hardwood furniture all create that rustic yet stylish bush atmosphere. En suite facilities, overhead fans and mosquito nets are just a few of the little things that Thornhill always provides to ensure our guest's comfort.

DIRECTIONS FROM JOHANNESBURG/ PRETORIA:

BY ROAD: Take the N4 from Johannesburg/ Pretoria. Bypass Witbank and Middelburg, turn off at Belfast R33 continue onto Belfast. From Belfast take the R540 to Dullstroom and then on to Lydenburg. From Lydenberg take the R36 to Orighstad and continue straight until you pass through the JG Strijdom Tunnel. From the tunnel continue for approx. 27 km before turning right at the Reptile Park, taking the R531 towards Orpen. Continue straight for about 30km until the R531 becomes the R40, following the direction to White River. After +/- 2 km on the R40 turn left on to the R531, direction Orpen Gate. Drive for about 2 km. At the sign posted Guernsey turn left onto the dirt road. Pass through the security gate. Continue along the dirt road for about 8 km until you see the signpost for Guernsey Private Nature Reserve on your right-hand side. Turn right into the corridor road and travel until you reach the entrance gates to Guernsey Private Nature Reserve. Once inside follow the wooden signs to Thornhill safari lodge.

BY AIR: There are flights daily from Johannesburg O R Tambo airport to Hoedspruit Airport and flights twice a week from Cape Town directly to Hoedspruit. If pre-arranged our transfer vehicle can collect you from either Hoedspruit Airport (Eastgate Airport) at no cost, or Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport in Nelspruit at a small fee. Please ask your agent for more information.

ABOUT THE KRUGER:

Kruger National Park, in the Mpumalanga Province of South Africa, is among the world's greatest nature reserves. It is one of the few places on earth where wildlife can be seen in such great variety and at such close quarters. Some 520 bird, 114 reptile and 146 mammal species, including the fabled Big Five - elephant, rhino, lion, leopard and buffalo, densely populate the park. Although in nature there are no guarantees, in Kruger Park you stand the best chance of thrilling sightings of game. From some of Africa's largest prides of lion, to birds found nowhere else within the country's borders.



The present Kruger Park is immense, covering 19,685 km2, an area almost the size of Wales or two thirds of Belgium. There are more than 3000 km of roads on which to explore the Park. Obviously in a limited time, one can do only so much, however our experience shows us which are the best roads to take at certain times of the year, ensuring you get the most of your visit to the Park. Our tour focuses mainly on the Central and Southern areas of the park, as it has the largest concentration of game.

CLIMATE:

In winter (April to September) the days are mild (average about 23°C), with sometimes cool nights (down to 6°C). In the summer the days average 30°C, but sometimes exceed 40°C, with the welcome cooling effect of afternoon thunderstorms. Rain in the summer months (October - March i.e. "rainy season") varies from about 800mm in the south, to 500mm in the northern areas.
