### ITINERARY

**DAY 1**  
**JOHANNESBURG TO KRUGER NATIONAL PARK**

Today you will make your way to the Kruger National Park. You can either transfer to the camp by road,



or fly-in direct to Skukuza within the Kruger Park. For those on the transfer by road, you will be met at the entrance gate to the park by your guide and from there transfer in an open safari vehicle to your camp for the night. A quick lunch will be enjoyed before checking into your accommodation. After a short break you will be collected by your guide and taken on an afternoon game drive and the first real opportunity to see this natural heritage up close.

You will return to camp around sunset as the gates to the camps close. You then meet up for dinner to discuss the day and the program for the next day.

## DAY 2 KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

With an early morning wake-up call we come together to enjoy a quick coffee before heading out on an early morning game drive. The Kruger Park is similar in size to Wales or Israel and has an incredibly rich ecosystem. We will spend the morning out and enjoy breakfast at a convenient stop.

You will have some time during the heat of the day to relax in camp, enjoy a swim, or even catch up on some sleep. Your guide will arrange a pick-up time for you to go out on an afternoon drive. Keep your eyes open for that elusive leopard that may be on an afternoon prowl. You will return to camp at gate closing time and have some time to freshen up before we meet for dinner.

## DAY 3 KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

The best time in the park is arguably the early mornings, so without wasting any time we head out early and do some more exploring of the area. This may include river drives, stopping at viewpoints and perhaps even visiting a hide. Breakfast will be enjoyed at a suitable stop, before heading back to camp for another break.

Meeting up in the early afternoon you will have another chance to search for new species and at the same time enjoy more special encounters with species that may have been seen before. In the African bush you never can tell what you will find, but exciting fauna and flora will be there to enjoy. This will be your last evening in the park. Take a moment to enjoy the night skies and if you are lucky you may even get to see one of the smaller nocturnal species out on the move.

Today is your last day and you have a short drive back to the entrance gate to the park where you will be met by your driver/guide who will drive you back to Johannesburg.

For those flying out from Skukuza, your guide will drive you to the airport for your onward flight.

## Tour Information

### ACCOMMODATION:

Accommodation is in circular chalets referred to as 'rondawels'. Each chalet has two or 3 singles beds, en-suite toilet and shower facilities as well as an air-conditioner.



### WHAT'S INCLUDED:

Accommodation for 3 nights while in the Kruger Park. Breakfasts, Dinners. Bottled water during drives. Coffee and tea before morning drives. Open safari vehicle for all drives within the Kruger Park. Daily conservation fees and entrance fees to the Kruger National Park. A professional, qualified field guide for the duration of your safari in the Kruger Park. One sunset drive conducted by a SANParks ranger

### WHAT'S EXCLUDED:

Flights to and from South Africa. Pre and post safari accommodation. Lunches. Alcoholic beverages. Travel insurance. Personal items. Snacks. Medical fees. Other items or services not specifically mentioned as being included.

### JOINING INFORMATION:

We pick up from most Accommodation establishments in the Johannesburg area, please confirm the relevant details with your reservations agent. The journey to and from the lodge is in the comfort of an air-conditioned microbus.



### **TOUR END POINT:**

You can be dropped off at your accommodation in Johannesburg or the Airport, if you are flying out the same day please book national flights for 8pm or after and international flights for 10 pm or after.

### **ABOUT THE KRUGER:**

Kruger National Park, in the Mpumalanga Province of South Africa, is among the world's greatest nature reserves. It is one of the few places on earth where wildlife can be seen in such great variety and at such close quarters. Some 520 bird, 114 reptile and 146 mammal species, including the fabled Big Five - elephant, rhino, lion, leopard and buffalo, densely populate the park. Although in nature there are no guarantees, in Kruger Park you stand the best chance of thrilling sightings of game. From some of Africa's largest prides of lion, to birds found nowhere else within the country's borders.

The present Kruger Park is immense, covering 19,685 km<sup>2</sup>, an area almost the size of Wales or two thirds of Belgium. There are more than 3000 km of roads on which to explore the Park. Obviously in a limited time, one can do only so much, however our experience shows us which are the best roads to take at certain times of the year, ensuring you get the most of your visit to the Park. Our tour focuses mainly on the Central and Southern areas of the park, as it has the largest concentration of game.

### **CLIMATE:**

In winter (April to September) the days are mild (average about 23° C), with sometimes cool nights (down to 6° C). In the summer the days average 30° C, but sometimes exceed 40° C, with the welcome cooling effect of afternoon thunderstorms. Rain in the summer months (October - March i.e. "rainy season") varies from about 800mm in the south, to 500mm in the northern areas.
