

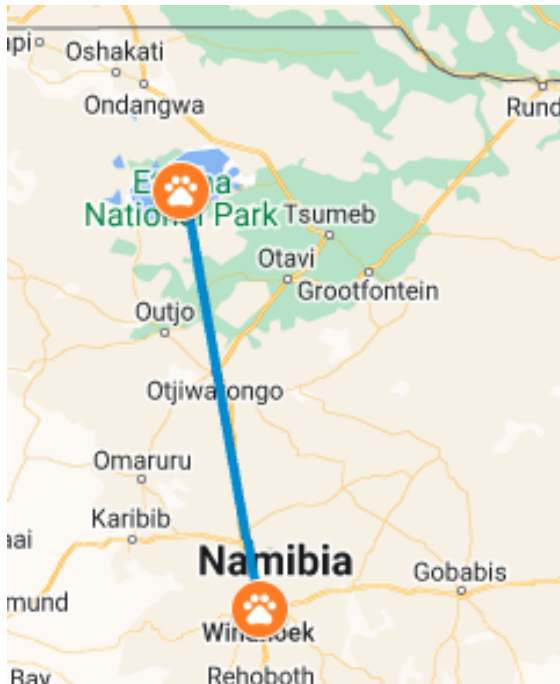

This safari starts from Swakopmund every Saturday and ends in the vibrant city of Windhoek on Mondays.

This adventure tour focuses exclusively on Etosha National Park, world famous for its waterholes teeming with wildlife. Etosha provides a perfect setting to experience an authentic African safari. With great sightings of lions, elephants, giraffes and many other species of smaller animals. With flood lit water holes, we have great photo opportunities both day and night.

# TOUR ITINERARY

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## 3 Days| Namibia

Information is subject to change. Travel times and accommodation can change depending on road or weather conditions, etc. These are used as a guideline only.

### DAY 1:

Ready for an epic 3-day journey? Your adventure begins at 9:00 AM from Swakopmund. Note that our designated pick-up points include The Residence, Amanpuri Travellers Lodge, Dunedin Star Guesthouse, and Hotel A La Mer. If your accommodation isn't on our list, please make your way to one of these points by 8:45 AM.

Get ready to embark on a scenic drive to Etosha National Park, passing through Outjo. Keep your eyes peeled for big game as we enter the park and head to Okaukuejo Camp. Once we set up camp, if time allows, we'll head out for an afternoon game drive. Elephants, rhinos, giraffes, and big cats – we're on the lookout for them all.

We head back to camp at sunset, where the wildlife spectacle continues after dark. Just a short stroll from our campsite, Okaukuejo takes the spotlight with its renowned flood-lit waterhole. Here, we're treated to a front-row seat to witness Etosha's treasures. This is the prime opportunity to get up close to a black rhino. Namibia stands as the last stronghold for these critically endangered creatures, and at Okaukuejo, they make regular appearances, making it a truly extraordinary experience.

### DAY 2:

We've got an entire day to delve into the wonders of Etosha, and we're determined to make the most of every moment. As the park gates open with the sunrise, we start the day with a coffee and head out quickly to spot the big cats returning from their nocturnal hunts. In the heart of Etosha's desert landscape, water is a precious rarity. However, the park boasts numerous waterholes, and our game plan involves visiting as many as possible.

We enjoy a pit stop at one of the designated picnic areas, savoring a delicious breakfast before continuing our game drive towards the Halali camp. On arrival at Halali, we enjoy lunch and take a refreshing dip in the pool. We also have time to visit the camp waterhole before heading out on our afternoon game drive.

En route to Okaukuejo, we pause for a closer look at the magnificent Etosha Pan. Though the name translates to 'great white space,' it scarcely captures the immensity of this dazzling white mineral pan spanning over 4,700 square km — visible even from space. As we wind our way back to Okaukuejo, staying vigilant for wildlife, our goal is to reach the campsite just before sunset. This timing ensures we catch the magic of the Okaukuejo waterhole during the best hour of the day.

### DAY 3:

Time to pack up camp! We'll go on a game drive to the park exit, hoping to spot predators. On our way to Windhoek, we'll make a pit stop in Okahandja to refuel and explore Namibia's largest wood carving market. Grab a unique Namibian souvenir and support local artists. We aim to get you back to Windhoek by late afternoon, with a shuttle ready to drop you off at your city accommodation.

## SINGLE TRAVELLERS:

You will be matched with another traveller of the same gender on a twin share basis. Speak to your consultant if you prefer to have your own tent.

## PARTICIPATION:

Safari is on a full participation basis, meaning you have to put up and break down your own tent as well as clean your own dishes.

## HEALTH:

Please inform us of any pre-existing conditions such as diabetes or asthma and any prescription medicine you may be taking. We also need to know about any food allergies or physical disability that you may have.

## VISAS:

Please note that these are your responsibility. Some nationalities require visas for Namibia.

## INSURANCE:

All clients require adequate Travel Insurance. Medical Insurance is not sufficient. Activity providers can refuse participation of activities, if the correct valid Travel Insurance is not provided.

## CLIMATE:

The African sun is very strong. Please use a factor 30 sunscreen and wear a hat. You should drink at least 3 litres of water per day to avoid dehydration.

## VACCINATIONS:

No vaccinations are prescribed by law for the countries being visited on this tour.

If you require accommodation before or after your tour we can arrange this for you. We can also arrange airport transfers – contact your consultant to make these bookings.
